CAMP INSTRUCTORS

Brad Smiley - Head Football Coach

Brad Smiley completed his second year as head football coach with TVCC in 2008, a season that provided a lot excitement. The Cards opened the season 4-0, with impressive wins, averaging 48.5 points per contest and reaching as high as #12 in the national polls. After suffering back-to-back losses to the #1 and #5 NJCAA ranked teams, the Cardinals finished strong to propel them into the regional championship playoffs. Trinity Valley finished the 2008 season ranked #21 in the final polls. The Cardinals had 6 players in 2008 earn 1st or 2nd Team All-Conference honors, along with 7 conference players of the week and 3 national players of the week. In Smiley's two seasons at the helm, TVCC has had 10 SWJCFCA All-Conference performers and 1 NJCAA All-American.

William Reed - Assistant Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator

A veteran coach of all levels of football, from high school to the NFL, Will Reed has just finished his second season as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach. Reed was instrumental in this year's run to the regional semi-finals, leading a defensive unit that finished #14 nationally in total defense and was #10 nationally against the pass. The stingy Cardinal defense was brutal on opposing quarterbacks, sporting three defensive players that tied for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the nation in interceptions and ranked #6 in touchdown passes allowed. The 2008 season's defense also had two players recognized as the NJCAA's National Defensive Player of the Week.

John Launius - Offensive Coordinator/Quarterbacks

John Launius just finished his second year with Trinity Valley, directing a high-flying offense that put up big numbers in 2008. The offense included several All-Conference performers that finished among the top of the league in passing, rushing and receiving. The Cards' balanced offensive attack ranked among the best in the SWJCFCA and the nation. TVCC ranked in the top 18 nationally in passing offense (#18), rushing offense (#15), total offense (#13) and touchdown passes (#12).

Eric Jones - Assistant Football Coach - Defensive Line

Eric Jones arrives at TVCC bringing a wealth of experience as a football coach and player. He spent the 2007 season with new SWJCFCA foe Arkansas Baptist College as defensive line coach. He also served as defensive line coach in 2005 and 2006 with Paul Quinn College in Dallas, Texas and has coached at several high schools in the DFW metroplex, including Grace Prep, where he helped the squad vie for a state championship.

Mark Gibson - Assistant Football Coach - Defensive Backs

Former SMU defensive back and Duncanville High School standout Mark Gibson joined the TVCC family in 2008. He has coached at the college, junior college and high school levels. He spent time with former Dallas Cowboys head coach Jimmy Johnson on his staffs at both Oklahoma State University and the University of Miami, as well as coaching stints at New Mexico State, UNLV, and the University of Pacific. At the University of Miami, Gibson was on the staff that played for the National Championship in the 1986 Sugar Bowl.

J Pond - Offensive Line

This is J Pond's first year with the Cardinals as offensive line coach. He spent the past two seasons at Sul Ross State University, where he searved as offensive line coach and recruiting coordinator. In his two seasons in Alpine, TX, the Lobos offensive line led the way for one of the American Southwest Conference's most potent rushing attacks. Pond was also a member of the Aggie football team under the reign of head coach Dennis Franchione and offensive line coach Jim Bob Helduser.
