**MIPO1502 ALCOHOL AWARENESS/MINOR IN POSSESSION** - Alcohol Education Approved Texas Commission on Alcohol & Drug Abuse. Classes are 6 hours (two 3 hour classes), plus an individual exit interview. Depending on the number of students enrolled, exit interview may be conducted after the second night of class or, if enrollment is large, students may be required to return for the interview. Interview must be completed to receive credit for the class. Students must pre-register, in person, for this class. Students under 16 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian for **REGISTRATION**. (6 hours)
