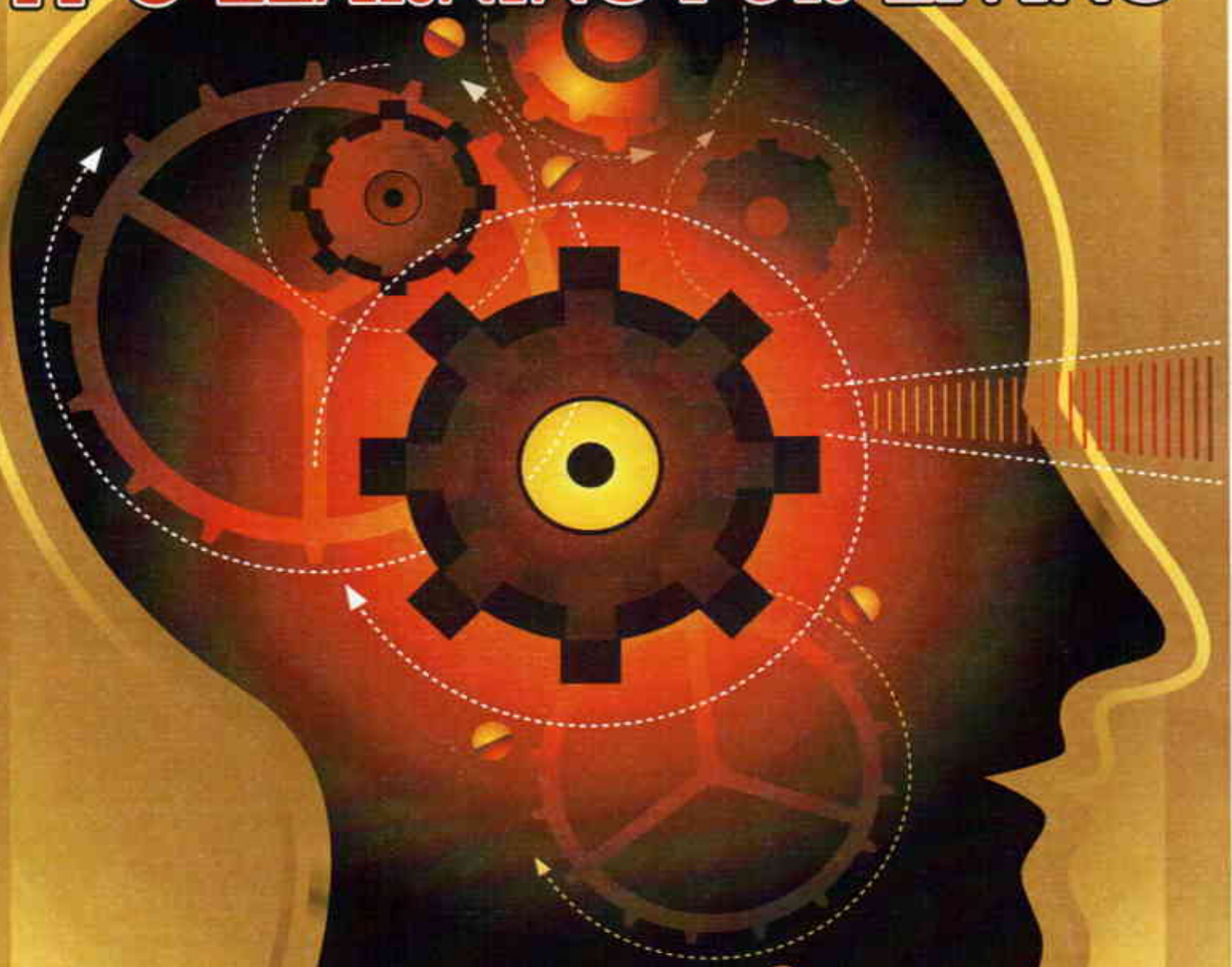

Learning for Living Academy

Would you like to be an Artist or a Photographer? Do you want to learn more about computers? Or maybe you want to learn a new skill for work or play.

The TVCC Learning for Living Academy gives students the opportunity to gain new knowledge and learn new skills. Students can enroll in selected credit classes as a non-credit student .

Learning for Living Academy allows students to take academic classes in

- ❖ Arts & Sciences
- ❖ Languages
- ❖ Social Studies
- ❖ Physical Fitness and Sports
- ❖ Technology and most workforce skills classes.

Need to Know

1. **What is the difference between Learning for Living (LLA) classes and auditing or "piggybacking" a credit class?**

❖ Enrollment is basically the same as auditing (Piggyback/Mirrored Classes). The non-credit student can enroll in and participate in a college credit class.

2. **Are all college credit courses available for the Learning for Living Academy?**

❖ No. Most of the credit classes are available, however some classes will require some pre-requisite criteria. There are some classes that are only offered as a credit class, and not available to LLA students.

❖ Non-credit LLA enrollments are on a "space available basis". Credit students have priority in all classes. If a LLA student is "bumped" from a class, a full refund of the tuition will be given.

3. **Will I receive a grade in the Learning for Living Academy Class?**

❖ Yes.

4. **Will I receive a certificate or transcript showing I have completed the class?**

❖ Yes. Students will receive a TVCC certificate documenting the number of Continuing Education Units (CEUs) earned by successfully completing the class.

❖ Grades for non-credit classes are transcribed. Transcripts for non-credit classes are available free of charge by contacting the Community Services Department. Transcripts list all non-credit courses attempted.

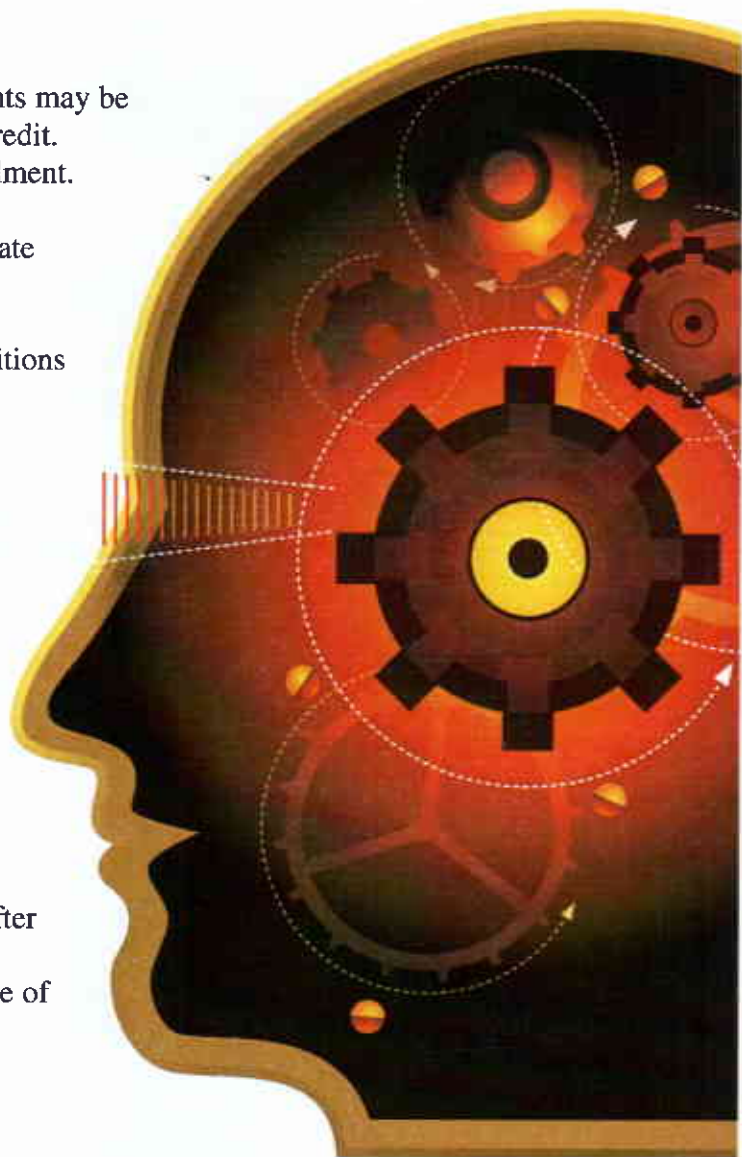

TVCC Learning for Living Academy Guidelines

The TVCC Learning for Living Academy (LLA) gives students the opportunity to gain new knowledge and learn new skills. The Academy is designed for students who wish to take the same college level classes as “credit” students, but wish to do it for the experience and not the credit.

Guidelines for students wishing to enroll in Learning for Life are as follows:

- Classes taken as part of the Learning for Living Academy cannot be converted to credit hours. They will not apply to degrees, credit certificates or for transfer to other colleges for credit.
- Enrollment is subject to TVCC approval.
- Enrollment is on a space-available basis. Students may be “bumped” by students enrolled in the class for credit. Some classes may not make due to lack of enrollment.
- Enrollment is available, through the last day of late enrollment. Some prerequisites may apply.
- In-district tuitions will apply for all students. Tuitions are based on in-district rates plus lab fees.
- Students must abide by all rules as published in the TVCC catalog. Students are expected to meet the instructor’s expectations.
- LLA students will need all of the study materials required for the class. Students may contact the TVCC bookstore for books and supply requirements and purchase. Students should not open textbooks or software until they know they will not be “bumped” from the class.
- Students can enroll in a LLA class at any time after the credit class schedule is available. Enrollments will be accepted through the last date of “late enrollment” for all college credit courses. Enrollments are accepted at all TVCC campuses. Registration forms and payments can be faxed or mailed to the address on the form.
- Gold Card benefits will apply to LLA classes. Adults 60 years of age or older who live in the TVCC tax district can purchase a TVCC Gold Card. One of the benefits of the Gold Card is an automatic 50% reduction in tuition for credit or LLA classes.
