The Texas Virtual School Network (TxVSN) is a consortium of Texas community colleges that offer dual-credit courses to high school students wishing to receive college credit while still in high school. The TxVSN operates on a Host-Provider model. TVCC serves as the Provider to the high school student and the Host to the VCT model. The VCT Provider is the community college providing the instruction.
