Part A. The required questions are as follows:

- _____ 2) Have you ever been convicted of an offense under Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code (Texas Controlled Substances Act), or under the law of another jurisdiction involving a controlled substance as defined by Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code?

If your answer to either question is “yes”, you are NOT eligible for a TEXAS Grant **unless** you can provide the Director of Student Financial Services proof that you have met one of the following conditions:

- _____ 3) If you have received a certificate of discharge by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or a correctional facility or completed a period of probation ordered by a court, and at least two years have elapsed from the date of the receipt or completion, **OR**
- _____ 4) You have been pardoned, had the record of the offense expunged from your record, or otherwise have been released from the resulting ineligibility to receive a grant.
