GENERAL STATEMENT:

Installs, troubleshoots, and repairs plumbing equipment and systems involving plumbing work of a broad nature.

REPORTS TO:

Director of Plant Operations

QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT:

EDUCATION:

High school diploma or GED.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION:

Master Plumbers License or Journeyman Plumber

EXPERIENCE:

Five (5) years work experience as a master plumber or eight (8) years as a journeyman plumber.

OTHER:

Knowledge and use of all required plumbing tools and measuring and testing equipment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Install and maintain plumbing equipment.
- Change lavatories, stools, and faucets as needed.
- Check and replace sprinkler heads and timing to see that they are functioning properly.
- Check and maintain a watchful eye on all gas equipment and appliances.
- Work on water and gas lines to see that they are functioning properly.
- Keep all sewer lines in proper working condition and unplugged.
- Occasionally work with other trades.
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Plant Operations or other appropriate supervisory personnel.

PLUMBER

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- May be required to lift, push, or pull fifty (50) pounds.
