<p><u>Project Outcome:</u></p>	<p>Faculty/Staff will become more familiar with networking techniques and gain experience using those techniques.</p>
<p><u>Project Summary:</u></p>	<p>On-line communications for interested faculty in which one networking technique will be introduced. Faculty is then encouraged to use or adapt in their classrooms. When all have reported back on usage, a new networking technique will be offered. Participation will result in New Innovation Journal entries (in this folder) and an updated Teacher Manual.</p>
<p><u>Project Challenges:</u></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Interested faculty will be formed into teams for discussion groups; will require ongoing participation in online activities.2. Techniques will need to be adapted for various disciplines, requiring creativity and willingness to experiment.3. Each technique will have a time limit, so continued attention will be important.
