

CRLA International Tutor Certification

Beginning this year all TVCC Student Support Services peer tutors will have the option of working towards *College Reading and Learning Association International Tutor Certification* (ITCP).

ITCP will recognize and offer certification of your success as a tutor through a combination of hours of tutoring experience and in-service continuing education hours.

There are three levels of certification:

- Regular
- Advanced
- Master

Each level requires 10 additional hours of training and 25 additional hours of tutoring experience. After the required TVCC in-service workshops, the additional hours can be earned through a combination of workshop, video, on-line in-service hours. In-service classes and workshops will be held weekly. Times and topics will be posted in the lab and on the TVCC Tutor YAHOO List Serve.

Tutor benefits are:

- Your tutoring experience and commitment will be recognized.
- Certification will follow you when you leave TVCC. It is recognized at over 700 colleges and universities.
- Student Support Services will pay certified tutors commensurate with their level of certification.

CRLA certifies tutoring programs. Currently our program, Student Support Services of TVCC, Athens campus, is in process of certification. During this initial program certification phase, individual tutor hours towards certification will be retroactive for one year from date of certification. (This means any of your tutoring and in-service hours completed from one year before our certification will count towards your individual certification.)

ITCP Certification is a valuable achievement that acknowledges your proficiency as a tutor.

It is a documented and marketable academic and work skill that can be cited on scholarship applications and résumés.
