

Trinity Valley Community College Community Services Department Collaborations, 2005-2006

The TVCC Community Services Department provides a variety of types of educational programs to meet the evolving training and community service program needs of the citizens of our service area. In many cases these evolve out of collaborations with members of our communities. The most recent and active collaborations include:

(1) Independent School Districts in Henderson County

(2) Other Educational Entities such as Harris County Department of Education, Bill Priest Institute of Dallas, University of Texas Medical Branch in Tyler, Texas A & M University System, University of Texas at Tyler,

(3) Medical facilities and organizations such as Lake Country Area Health Education Center with University of Texas Medical Branch, Palestine Regional Medical Center, Terrell State Mental Hospital, Lakeland Medical Center, East Texas Medical Center of Athens, Southplace Nursing Home, Freestate Crestwood Nursing Home in Wills Point, Windsor Care Senior Facility in Terrell, Cartmell Nursing home in Palestine, Trinity Mother Frances Hospital (Rural division), Presbyterian Hospital in Kaufman, Baylor Medical Center in Terrell, etc. ;

(4) Workforce Boards - East Texas Workforce Development Board and ACS, Inc. which manages their workforce centers, and the North Central Workforce Development Board and Neighborhood Services, Inc. which manages their workforce centers;

(5) Economic development corporations in Athens, Canton, Chandler, Terrell, Palestine and Gun Barrel City;

(6) Governmental agencies such as the Texas Adult Protective Services Agency, Texas Department of Corrections, Texas Educational Agency, Texas Department of Human Services, Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services, Texas Agricultural Extension Service, Texas Rehabilitation Commission, U.S. Department of Labor, and others.
