| x | Fully Attained | <p>#1 Objective was fully obtained. The Student Union Building became a more attractive, and functional facility for the use of students and area high schools.</p> <p>#3 Objective was fully attained. The student senate worked with a local church by adopting two needy families for Christmas. Approximately, twenty students interviewed families, purchased and delivered presents for the holiday season. The Senate was a finalist for the TJCSGA Chapter of the Year award.</p> |
| x | Partially Attained | <p>#2 Objective was partially attained. The web page for Student Activities/Student Senate was designed as an extra credit project by computer technology students. However, it was not added to the college server this year due to technical problems. These problems will be revisited in the coming months.</p> <p>#5 Objective was partially attained. Female and coed-ed divisions were successfully established for intramural volleyball and softball leagues. However, females did not participate in flag football.</p> <p>#6 Objective was partially attained. Student groups adopted four campus areas for improvement. Students planned, designed, and installed plants at four campus locations. Other areas were not adopted.</p> |
| x | Not attained | <p># 4 Objectives was not obtained. The concrete in front of the student union building prohibited seating benches from being installed. Future planned renovations of this area were also a factor in non-attainment of this objective.</p> |
