I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. Attend all classes unless properly excused.
2. Enroll in and complete at least twelve (12) semester hours with a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0. One **three or four hour** Agriculture / Ranch Management course per semester to be included.
3. Active participation on the Beef Cattle Show Team, which will include:

- Working with the show cattle per TVCC instructions a minimum of 3 days per week at a time predetermined by instructor for a period of 2-3 hours each session.
 - Attending a maximum of two major livestock shows each semester.
 - May be required to alternate with other students in feeding and caring for the show cattle during the Christmas holidays and on weekends.
 - Attend one of the McPeak's "Be A Champ" Show Cattle Camp's IF you have never done so before or if you do not clip and fit long haired cattle for show at an experienced level. (www.beachamp.com)
4. Provide leadership and help with the activities of the department to include but not limited to the following:
 - Recruiting of new students.
 - Help with Trinity – Neches Soil and Water Conservation District Plant Judging Contest (approx. 12:00 PM to 02:30 PM on a Tuesday in September)
 - Help with East Texas State Fair Steer Show (Sunday 08:30 AM to 05:00 PM in October).
 - Help with Sandyland District FFA Leadership Contest held on a Friday during the first of November.
 - Help with Show Calf Clinic and/or Dash for Cash livestock show held in Athens by the HCLS, usually on the second Saturday in December (08:00 AM to 05:00 PM).
 - Help with the Henderson County Breeding and Market Cattle Shows on a Friday afternoon and evening during the last part of March.
 5. Placement on disciplinary probation will automatically void this scholarship.
 6. Obey all rules and regulations of Trinity Valley Community College.
 7. A scholarship acceptance agreement will be signed.
 8. Current transcript of all high school and college work MUST be provided.
