## **Bull Guarantee**

### **TVCC Ranch**

Trinity Valley Community College bulls have been fertility tested and guaranteed breeders for **one breeding season**. TVCC does not guarantee the ability of the semen to freeze. In the event an animal is claimed to be a non-breeder, the bull may be returned to the seller at the buyer's expense under the following conditions: A) The bull must be in good physical condition with a Vet Health Certificate stating condition and problem with the bull. The bull must be tested for Brucellosis and Trichomoniasis and be negative for these diseases prior to returning. This is at the buyer's expenses. B) TVCC's guarantee is to replace the bull with a bull of equal or more value as soon as one becomes available. C) TVCC has the right to retest the bull within 30 days after the bull is returned. The registration papers on all bulls will be transferred to buyers upon checks clearing the banks.

\*\*\*When purchasing and using breeding age bulls less than two-years of age, it is even more imperative that these bulls not be left out with cows for more than approximately 90 days during their first breeding season. These young bulls are actively growing as well as shedding their front two center baby incisors at about 18 months of age so they can grow their permanent incisors and thus need some supplemental feeding. Once the bulls are removed from the cow herd after the first breeding season, they should be on some type of supplemental feeding in addition to free-choice hay or green forage and loose mineral. A bull and heifer type ration high in energy and moderate in protein is recommended.
