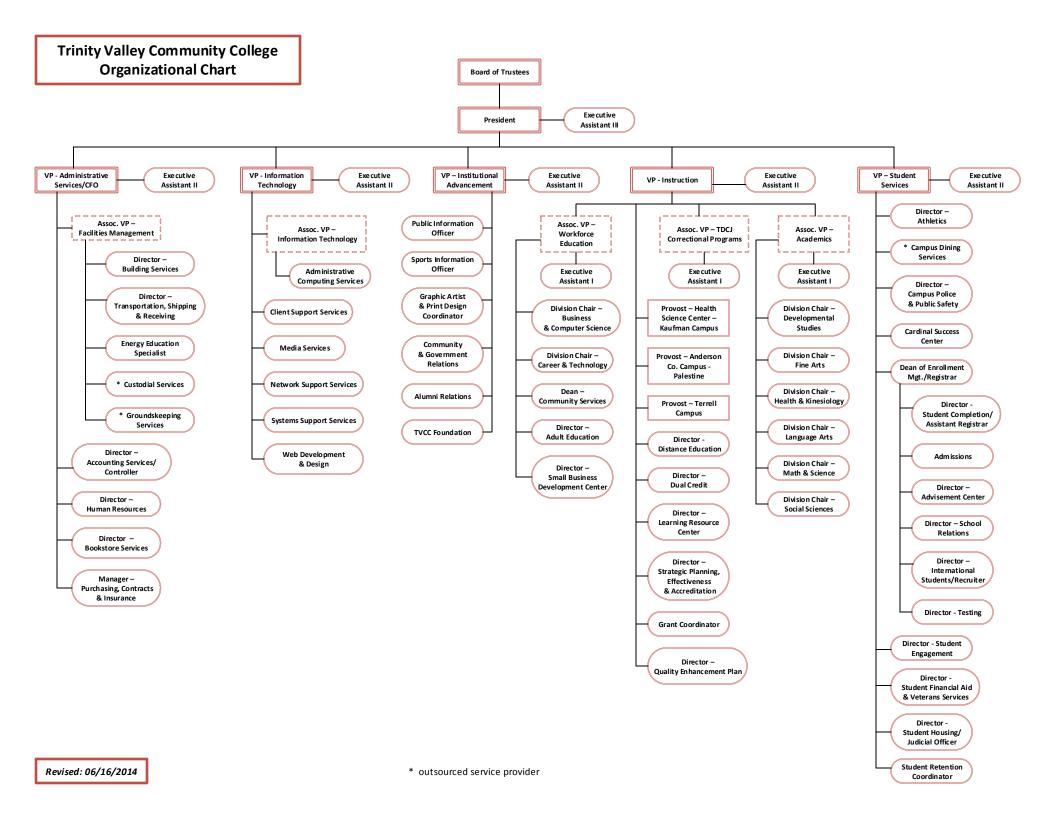

Trinity Valley Community College is a comprehensive community college providing both credit and non-credit courses in the areas of academic transfer and workforce education to a five county service area in East Texas. Courses are taught at the Athens campus, Palestine campus, Terrell campus, Kaufman Health Science Center, at four Texas Department of Corrections units at Tennessee Colony, and at area high schools. Trinity Valley Community College is governed by a Board of Trustees elected from nine (9) single member districts. The college manages all locations from the Athens campus where the central administration is located. There are limited administrative personnel located at the other locations.

Due to reductions in state funding, Trinity Valley continues to dedicate a larger portion of local funds to the operating budget, which greatly inhibits the college's ability to use those local funds to maintain adequate physical facilities. The need for extensive repairs and upgraded preventive maintenance programs for existing facilities, and to construct additional health education facilities to address the growing demand for nurses and other skilled health care professionals in Texas and across the country, is critical.

Trinity Valley Community College has long been proud of its conservative fiscal approach to providing quality, affordable educational programs to its students, and we continue to keep the cost of instruction as low as possible. Many institutions pay their personnel at much higher salaries than Trinity Valley. However, our ability to survive without continually raising the cost of education to our students and/or the cost of taxes to local property owners is in jeopardy. Raising the cost to the students will cause some of our students to discontinue their education at the post-secondary level. This is undesirable for both our local and state economies. Raising the cost to local property owners is in stark contrast of the property tax payer relief espoused in Austin and erodes the goodwill of the college with local supporters. Since state-aid, local taxes, and tuition and fees are the fundamental, basic resources for Trinity Valley; there remain few, if any, alternatives.

Trinity Valley respectfully submits this appropriation request within the required guidelines. Additionally, we endorse the \$2.011 billion request for student success funding for the 2016-17 biennium as communicated by the Texas Association of Community Colleges to the Legislative Budget Board and the Office of Governor in their letter dated July 16, 2014. Further, we also support TACC's request in that same letter that the state continue with the new funding strategy implemented during the 83rd legislative session which is to fund the \$2.011 billion in the General Appropriations Act through the three operating strategies of Core Operations, Student Success Points, and Contact Hour funding.
