QUICK FACTS: Truck Driving Training (Classroom and Hands-On)

A partnership between Trinity Valley Community College and Career Trucking School, Inc. (CTS)

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Qualified students-applicants must: 1) be at least 18 years of age, 2) have an acceptable driving record, 3) complete and pass a Department of Transportation Physical Exam. Qualified student-applicants must have the ability to read, write, and speak the English language, and meet the requirements of the Motor Carrier Federal Safety Regulations, and Qualifications of Drivers (<https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov>). High school diploma or GED is **not** required to attend training. A high school diploma or GED is **not** required to secure a CDL.

Eligible student-applicants **must** register in both areas of instruction: 1) CDL Written Skills and 2) Driving Skills for Transporting Passengers

Tuition and Fees: Tuition DOES NOT include the cost of the physical exam and the Commercial Driver's License. Students are responsible for their physical exam and Commercial Driver's License.

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COURSE INFORMATION:

CDL Written Skills

(CVOP-1005 Commercial Driver's License Written Skills)

This course provides classroom instruction on the basic operation of a commercial truck; the principles of visual search, signaling, speed management terrain management, and maneuvering in traffic; ways of recognizing hazardous situations in advance, emergency braking techniques, evasive actions, causes of skidding and jackknifing, and techniques for recovering from such emergencies; the function and operation of all key vehicle systems; and how to complete a Driver's Daily Log, hours of duty limits, required rest periods, the basic procedure for handling the scene of an accident, reporting accidents, basic first aid, and extinguishing fires. The course also helps students prepare for mastery of the Commercial Driver's License written examination. (80 hrs.)

Driving Skills for Transporting Passengers

(CVOP-1011 Driving Skills for Transporting Passengers)

Overview of the State of Texas Class A or Class B Commercial Driver's License driving test. In-depth coverage of the in-cab air brake test, proper shifting, right, and left-hand turns, movement in traffic, parking of a vehicle designed to transport passengers, highway and city driving, and backward movement and control. (80 hrs.) Prerequisite: CDL Written Skills
