

Phlebotomy Fast Track (Basic & Advanced)

Information needed:

- 1) Financial Aid – Optional
 - a. FAFSA (2022-2023) - FAFSA will not cover the cost of this class, but a [FAFSA Application](#) is required to determine eligibility for TPEG. A [CE Financial Aid Application](#) is required. TPEG **could** pay up to 50% (not to exceed \$550 and if funds are available.) of the tuition. The student is responsible for the remaining balance plus the cost of the books, supplies or testing fee. Per TVCC expectation, students are responsible for full tuition. If you are eligible for financial assistance, it will be applied to the student account.
 - i. Books, supplies and testing fee:
 1. Books:
 - a. Textbook \$150 plus tax (prices are subject to change) *
 - b. NHA (National Healthcareer Association) practice exams - \$100 plus tax (prices are subject to change) *
 2. Supplies:
 - a. Maroon scrubs
 - b. Closed toed shoes
 - c. Watch with a second hand
 3. Testing fee:
 - a. \$117 (You will pay NHA directly) *
- 2) Required Immunizations: (If you have received these immunizations, contact the high school/college you last attended, doctor's office, employer, parents, or grandparents, etc. to see if they have proof. If you are unable to find proof of immunizations, a TITER (blood tests) is required to determine if you have the antibodies in your system. If the antibodies are not found, the immunizations are required.) Email immunization records to conted@tvcc.edu.
 - a. Tetanus/Diphtheria (in the last 10 years)
 - b. MMR (Measles, Mumps, & Rubella) – 2 doses
 - c. Varicella (Chicken pox shot) – 2 doses
 - d. Hepatitis B – have completed the series (3 doses)
 - e. TB test or QuantiferON – No older than one year prior to class start date
 - f. Flu Shot – current season (Ex. 2022-2023)
- 3) Required DPS Background Check:
 - a. Create an account
 - b. On the right-hand side click "Criminal History Search"
 - c. Under Current Users: click "Search Database"
 - d. A disclaimer will appear read and check the box and click "Continue"
 - e. Enter YOUR information in all the fields and click "Continue"
 - f. A search confirmation page will come up. Make sure "Continue (Process Search)" is marked and Click "Continue".
 - g. When the results are finished, in the top right corner is a print button. Either print or screen shot the results and submit to conted@tvcc.edu.

- 4) Must have High School Diploma or GED and be 18 years of age. You do not have to submit your High School Diploma or GED.
- 5) Complete and submit the [Registration Form](#) with the class information.

Tuition for the phlebotomy class is about \$904.50*. Prices are subject to change. Per TVCC expectation, students are responsible for full tuition. If you are eligible for financial assistance, it will be applied to the student account.

Tuition, background check, and immunization records are due at the time of registration.
