NON-CREDIT PART-TIME PAY SCHEDULE

The flat rate pay for each Crew member is based on the following variables:

- 1. Crew Type There are 3 crew types, Setup, Production and Announcers. Each is equally important but is required to work a different amount of time based on their responsibility. For example, the Setup Crew arrives earlier and stays later than any other crew stays.
- 2. Start times The start times vary for different crews. The above calculation considers that while the Setup Crew may begin setting up 3 hours before the event, they are being paid up to 4:30 p.m. as a part of their regular work schedule. This means that on a Wednesday night they would be paid more for a single men's game than a women's game because of the start time of the men's game is later in the evening.
- 3. Estimated Time worked The estimated time in hours that a crewmember works for an event.
- 4. Minimum pay allowance Each crewmember will be paid at minimum \$100 for each event night or day.
