## TVCC 2006-2010 Graduation Report Summary

The collection of tables and charts in this report provide information on Trinity Valley Community College graduates in the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) defined 2006-2010 timeframe. This represents the calendar period of fall 2005 through summer of 2010.

#### The report has 5 sections:

- 1. Tables and charts presenting a top level summary of TVCC Degrees, Certifications, Core Completion, and Field of Study Awards
- 2. Charts breaking down the awards by educational type
- 3. Tables presenting award data by educational type and program/CIP
- 4. Tables and Charts presenting data on awards by ethnicity and racial background
- A graph plotting total distinct annual enrollment vs. Degrees/Certifications/CCC/FOS awards from 1998-2010

THECB reporting requirements for ethnicity changed for fall of 2010. Previously ethnicity was reported as racial categories including one for Hispanic. The realization that people of Hispanic origin may be racially diverse has resulted in a new category applying to all students. They may now identify as Hispanic, Non-Hispanic, or Unknown (not reporting) Ethnic Origin with a separate categorization for racial identity. The racial identity categories are now White, Black or African American, Asian, American Indian or Alaskan Native, International, Unknown or not reported, and Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. Additionally students may select multiple racial identities. All data in the Institutional Research data warehouse has been modified to meet the new criteria.

The final graph in the presentation represents annual enrollment vs. degrees awarded. It is interesting because it appears to show declining student performance for the period of 2007-2010. Prior to 2007, enrollment appears to be a 1 year leading indicator of a rise or fall in the number of degrees/certifications awarded. After 2007 the number of degrees/certifications awarded has flattened while enrollment has had a sharp rise.
