EDDIE KITE

Director of Intercollegiate Athletics

Eddie Kite begins his fourth year as Director of Intercollegiate Athletics at Trinity Valley Community College. He arrived at TVCC in 2019 as Athletic Coordinator after a successful five-year stint at Panola College as Head Women's Basketball Coach. Kite will serve his first year as an NJCAA Regional Representative on the Division 1 Men's Golf Committee.

During his time at Panola College, Kite amassed 84 wins while leading the Fillies to their first NJCAA National Tournament since 2005, and first Region XIV Conference Championship since 1977 in 2018. Kite was recognized as Region XIV Coach of the Year by his peers and TABC Junior College Women's Basketball Coach of the Year following the 2018 season. Kite also served as Region XIV Women's Basketball Chairman from 2017-19.

Prior to his stint at Panola College, Kite was Head Women's Basketball Coach at Connors State College, where he recorded 195 wins. The Cowgirls won the 2009 Bi-State Conference and Region II Championship to advance to their first NJCAA National Tournament since 1999 with a 30-5 record. He was recognized as conference Coach of the Year and the Region II Coach of the Year in 2009. The Cowgirls also won the 2011 Oklahoma Community College Athletic Association Championship with Kite receiving OCCAA Coach of the Year.

While at Connors State, Kite served as Region II Women's Basketball Chairman from 2005-2010. During 2010-11, Kite served as NJCAA Region II Assistant Women's Director. Kite served as Region II Women's Director from 2011-13 while serving on the NJCAA Division I Volleyball Committee.

He also has assistant coaching tenures at Central Florida Community College, East Texas Baptist University, Oral Roberts University, University of Montevallo, University of Mobile and University of Houston.

The Murchison, Texas native is a graduate of Brownsboro High School and attended TVCC. He and his wife, Sarah have two daughters, Aimee and Shelby, and a son, Clinton.

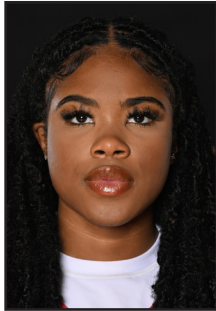
