CONSENT FOR STUDENT RELEASE OF INFORMATION

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 is a federal law designed to protect the privacy of aspects of a student's educational record that are not considered 'directory' information. Educational records include disability services records which are considered confidential and will not be released without written consent from the student, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent. For this reason, it is necessary for the STUDENT ACCESS AND COUNSELING at Trinity Valley Community College to obtain permission from a student in order to release any information related to the student's disability services and/or classroom accommodations not excluded by FERPA laws.
